5. Epidemiologist with expertise in modelling
6. Epidemiologist/public health/preventive medicine specialist with expertise in prevention and screening for colorectal cancer
7. Medical oncologist
8. Radiation oncologist
9. Nurse with experience in endoscopy and / or colorectal screening programs
10. Surgeon specialised colorectal cancer surgery
11. Screening program manager
12. Clinical laboratory (clinical chemistry, biochemistry, laboratory medicine) specialist with competence in quality assurance
13. Pathologist with expertise in molecular pathology

##### B. Minimum additional expertise to be included in the reserve list<sup>2</sup>

1. Nurse specialised in oncology
2. Radiologist specialised in gastrointestinal imaging
3. Interventional radiologist
4. Oncology pharmacist
5. Neuro-oncologist
6. Geriatric oncologist
7. Anaesthesiology / intensive care / pain management specialist
8. Palliative care specialist
9. Genetics specialist
