"Immediate family member" includes the individual's spouse, children and parents, irrespective whether they live at the same address or not.

"Spouse" includes a partner with whom the individual has a registered marital or non-marital regime.

"Children" refers to the child(ren) the individual and the spouse have in common, the own child(ren) of the individual and the own child(ren) of the spouse. In the corresponding section of the DoI form, please declare (if any) current direct interests related to the topic of colorectal cancer, i.e. employment, consultancy, strategic advisory role, financial interests, of your immediate family members.

"Legal entity" is any commercial business, industry association, consultancy, research institution or other enterprise whose funding is significantly derived from commercial sources. It also includes independent own commercial businesses, law offices, consultancies or similar.

"Body" implies a governmental, international or non-profit organisation.
